**05 Dec (Day 1):** ♦ **Dense fog** very likely in isolated pockets over Himachal Pradesh and Punjab.

♦ **Heavy rainfall** likely at isolated places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

♦ **Squally weather (speed 40-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph)** very likely over Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Andaman Sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

♦ **Squally winds (speed 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph)** very likely over Southeast Bay of Bengal & adjoining Andaman Sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

**06 Dec (Day 2):** ♦ **Heavy rainfall** likely at isolated places over Andaman & Nicobar Islands.

♦ **Squally winds (speed 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph)** likely over Southeast Bay of Bengal and over Southwest & adjoining Southeast Bay of Bengal. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas. Fisherman are advice not to venture into these areas.

**07 Dec (Day 3):** ♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning** very likely at isolated places over Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Kerala & Mahe.

♦ **Squally winds (50-60 kmph gusting to 70 kmph)** over Southwest Bay of Bengal & adjoining Sri Lanka coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas. Fisherman are advice not to venture into these areas.

**08 Dec (Day 4):** ♦ **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** likely at isolated places over Tamilnadu & Puducherry; **heavy rainfall** at isolated places over Rayalaseema and Coastal Andhra Pradesh.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning** very likely at isolated places over South Interior Karnataka, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Kerala & Mahe.

♦ **Squally winds (60-70 kmph gusting to 80 kmph)** over Southwest Bay of Bengal & adjoining Sri Lanka coast, along & off Tamilnadu, Puducherry, south Andhra Pradesh coast and Gulf of Mannar. Fisherman are advice not to venture into these areas.

**09 Dec (Day 5):** ♦ **Heavy rainfall** at isolated places likely over Rayalaseema, Tamilnadu and Coastal Andhra Pradesh.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning** very likely at isolated places over South Interior Karnataka, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Kerala & Mahe.

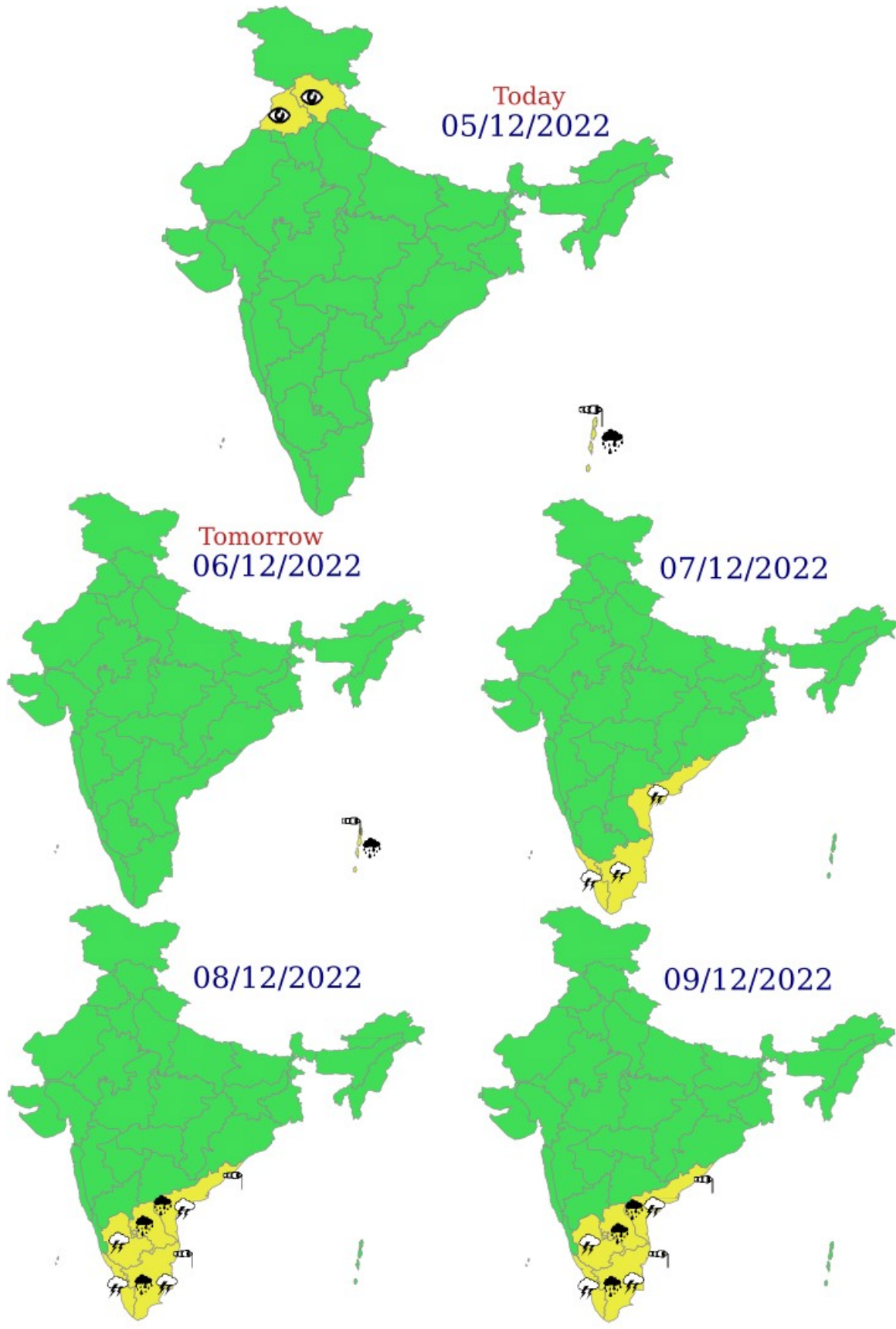

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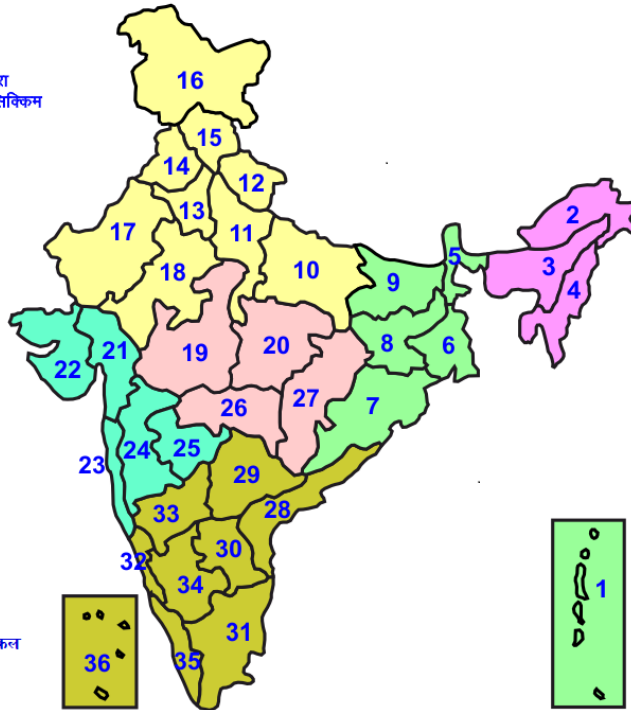
