



All India Weather Warning Bulletin

Sunday 29 January 2023
Time of Issue: 0830 hours IST

(MORNING)

29 Jan (Day 1): ♦ Heavy rainfall/snowfall very likely at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning, gusty wind (speed 30-40 kmph) & hail** very likely at isolated places over East Rajasthan; **with lightning & hail** likely at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Haryana, West Uttar Pradesh, West Rajasthan and **with lightning** at isolated places over Jammu, Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan & Muzaffarabad, north Gujarat Region, West Madhya Pradesh, East Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Maharashtra.

♦ **Dense fog** in isolated pockets very likely over Assam & Meghalaya, Mizoram and Tripura.

♦ **Squally weather** (wind speed reaching 40-45 gusting 55 kmph) likely over Southeast & adjoining Southwest Bay of Bengal. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

30 Jan (Day 2): ♦ Heavy rainfall/snowfall very likely at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & hail** likely at isolated places over Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Haryana, West Uttar Pradesh and **with lightning** at isolated places over Jammu, Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan & Muzaffarabad, East Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh.

♦ **Squally weather** (wind speed reaching 40-45 gusting 55 kmph) likely over Southwest & adjoining Southeast Bay of Bengal. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

31 Jan (Day 3): ♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning likely at isolated places over Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Kerala & Mahe.

♦ **Squally wind** (speed reaching 45-55 gusting to 65 kmph) likely over Southwest & adjoining Southeast Bay of Bengal and squally weather (wind speed reaching 40-45 gusting 55 kmph) over Southwest Bay of Bengal & along & off Sri-Lanka coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

01 Feb (Day 4): ♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning likely at isolated places over south Tamilnadu, south Kerala and Lakshadweep.

♦ **Squally wind** (speed reaching 40-45 gusting 55 kmph) over Southwest Bay of Bengal & along & off north Sri Lanka, south Tamil Nadu coast. **Squally weather** (wind speed reaching 45-55 gusting to 65 kmph) likely over Sri Lanka, Southwest Bay of Bengal and Gulf of Mannar and Comorin area. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

01 Feb (Day 5): ♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning likely at isolated places over south Tamilnadu, south Kerala and Lakshadweep.

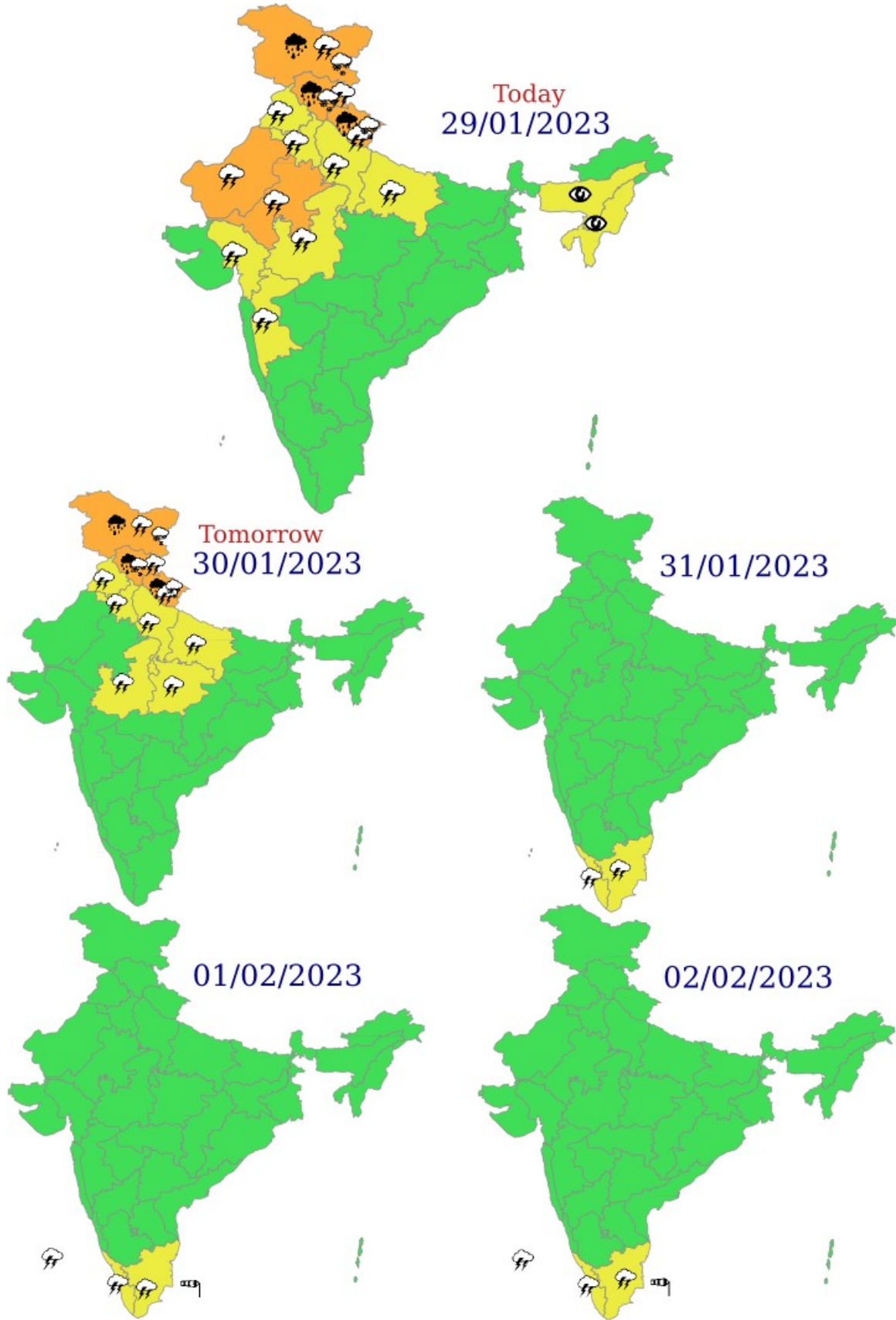
♦ **Squally wind** (speed reaching 40-45 gusting 55 kmph) over Southwest Bay of Bengal & along & off north Sri Lanka, south Tamil Nadu coast. **Squally weather** (wind speed reaching 45-55 gusting to 65 kmph) likely over Sri Lanka, Southwest Bay of Bengal and Gulf of Mannar and Comorin area. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

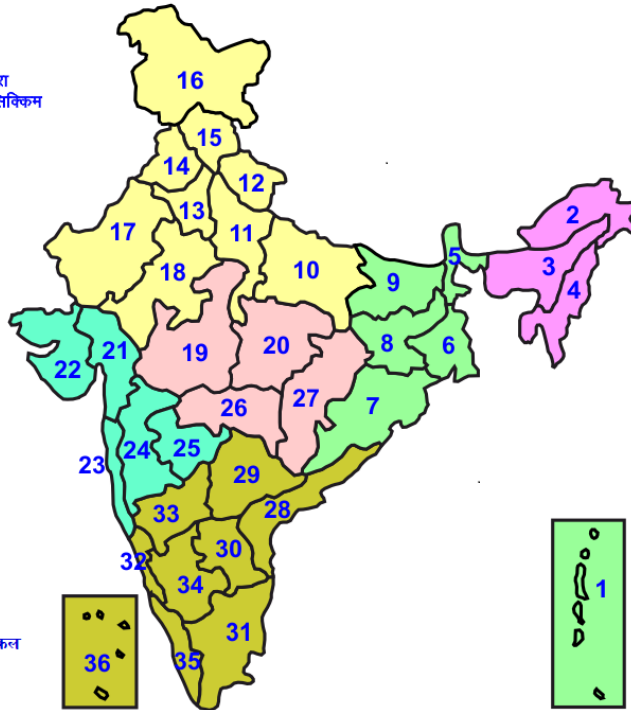
