		The National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) is the apex-level institution for disaster management in India. The Disaster Management Act, 2005 provides for setting up the NDMA along with a host of other institutions at the national, state, and district levels. Chaired by the Prime Minister, the NDMA is mandated to lay down the policies, plans, and guidelines for disaster management, and implement various programmes related to various aspects of disaster management. Since its inception, the NDMA has taken several initiatives and programmes in strengthening disaster preparedness, and mitigation, improving disaster response and recovery, and supporting capacity-building activities in the country.
		Specialist inputs in relevant discipline / areas of disaster management need to be provided to NDMA by Consultants / Sr. Consultants / Lead Consultants. They will provide domain specific technical assistance in formulation of guidelines / conduct of subject related training / other inputs on the subject from time to time as per requirements.
		The Sr. Consultant will provide effective and timely technical support and services to NDMA, States and UTs in undertaking disaster risk assessment and establishing damage and loss accounting systems. In addition the Incumbent will promote the use of disaster risk information in development planning and disaster risk management. He shall assist NDMA in organizing domain specific workshops/ seminars/ consultations etc with concerned stakeholders for efficient disaster management.

6. Tasks Related to Assignment & Job Description

Under the guidance and direct supervision of the Joint Secretary, PP Division, NDMA, the Sr. Consultant (Vulnerability Analysis – Disaster Risk assessment) will provide technical assistance to NDMA in formulation and implementation of policies, strategies and guidance related to Disaster risk assessment and to support coordination with International / Multilateral Agencies, Central and State government agencies, SDMAs and DDMAs. In addition, the Sr. Consultant will assist NDMA on developing preparedness and mitigation projects and organizing training and capacity building activities.

Tasks and Deliverables:

- 1. Provide technical support to NDMA, States and UTs that are undertaking disaster risk assessments and establishing damage and loss database as part of their disaster risk reduction efforts:
 - Provide technical inputs and advice on designing Disaster Risk Assessment initiatives as part of DRR programmes at the state level.
 - Promote the application of disaster risk information for decision making that contributes to disaster reduction.
 - Provide overall guidance and advice to end users of risk information on decision and policy making.
 - Review project proposals, project implementation planning, results and products related to risk assessments.
- 2. Lead the development of national guidelines on disaster risk Assessment and Damage and Loss Database, in close collaboration with key technical institutes in the country.
- 3. Promote knowledge management on Disaster Risk assessment, including the development of tools and methodologies and documentation of completed and ongoing risk assessment, lessons learned and best practices.
 - Identify and document systematically best practices and lessons learned in risk assessments and damage and loss database.
 - Prepare, coordinate and facilitate national and subnational seminars and training workshops on disaster risk assessments and damage and loss accounting systems.

		 Contribute to the identification and production of capacity development materials and delivery systems for risk-based decision making in development planning. Develop and deliver Training of Trainers (ToT) on risk assessment at the state level. Maintain a network of experts of disaster risk assessment specialists to service the needs of disaster risk assessment indicatives at the States, UT and city levels. Assist NDMA in organizing workshops/seminars /meetings etc with concerned stakeholders for undertaking disaster risk assessment, establishing damage and loss accounting systems and related matters and to put up draft minutes for approval of Competent Authority.
