

All India Weather Warning Bulletin

Sunday 29 May 2022

Time of Issue: 0815 hours IST

(MORNING)

29 May (Day 1): ♦ Heavy rainfall at isolated places very likely over Assam-Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura and Kerala & Mahe.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & hail gusty wind (speed 30-40)** at isolated places very likely over Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand; **with lightning/gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph)** at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, West Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal and Andaman & Nicobar Islands and **with lightning** at isolated places over East Uttar Pradesh, East Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Assam-Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Lakshadweep.

♦ **Squally weather** (wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph) very likely over Southeast Arabian Sea, Lakshadweep area, along and off south Kerala coast and adjoining Comorin area. **Strong winds** of 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely over Southwest Arabian Sea; Northeast Arabian Sea and adjoining north Gujarat coast. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

30 May (Day 2): ♦ Heavy rainfall at isolated places very likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Assam-Meghalaya, Kerala & Mahe and Lakshadweep.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning/gusty winds (speed 40-50 kmph)** at isolated places very likely over Gangetic West Bengal; **with lightning/gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph)** at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Bihar, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Konkan & Goa, and Jharkhand and **with lightning** at isolated places over Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Odisha, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Kerala & Mahe and Lakshadweep.

♦ **Squally weather** (wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph) very likely over Southeast Arabian Sea, Lakshadweep area, along and off south Kerala coast and adjoining Comorin area. **Strong winds** of 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph likely over Southwest Arabian Sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

31 May (Day 3): ♦ Heavy rainfall at isolated places likely over Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Assam-Meghalaya, Kerala & Mahe and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning/gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph)** at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada and Konkan & Goa; and **with lightning** at isolated places over Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Rayalaseema, Kerala & Mahe and Lakshadweep.

♦ **Squally weather** (wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph) likely over southwest Arabian Sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

01 June (Day 4): ♦ Heavy rainfall at isolated places likely over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam-Meghalaya, Kerala & Mahe and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning/gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph)** at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada and Konkan & Goa; and **with lightning** at isolated places over Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Rayalaseema, Kerala & Mahe and Lakshadweep.

♦ **Squally weather** (wind speed 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph) likely over southwest Arabian Sea. Fishermen are advised not to venture into these areas.

02 June (Day 5): ♦ Heavy rainfall at isolated places likely over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam-Meghalaya, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Kerala & Mahe and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning/gusty winds (speed 30-40 kmph)** at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada and Konkan & Goa; and **with lightning** at isolated places over Coastal Andhra Pradesh & Yanam, Rayalaseema, Kerala & Mahe and Lakshadweep.

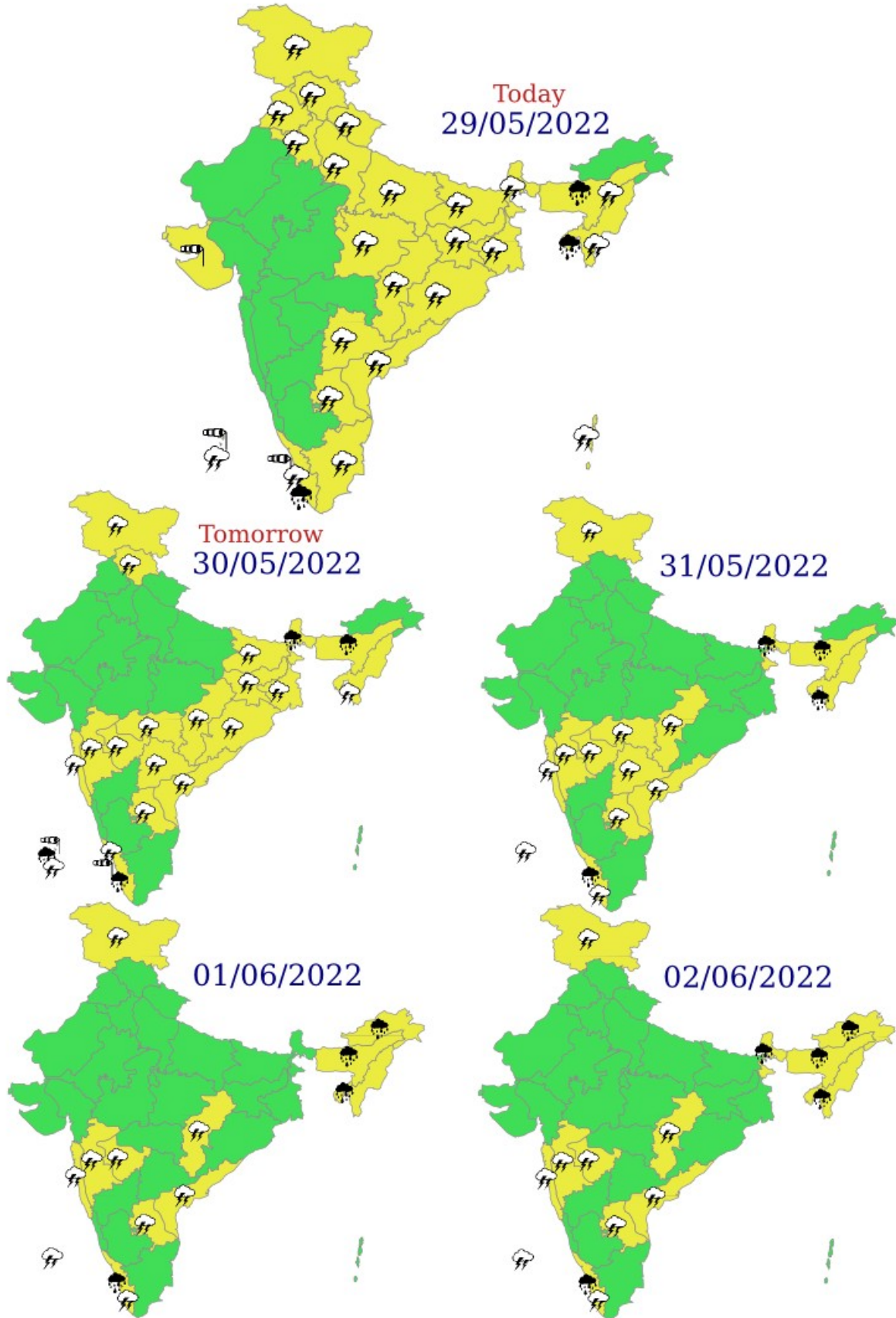

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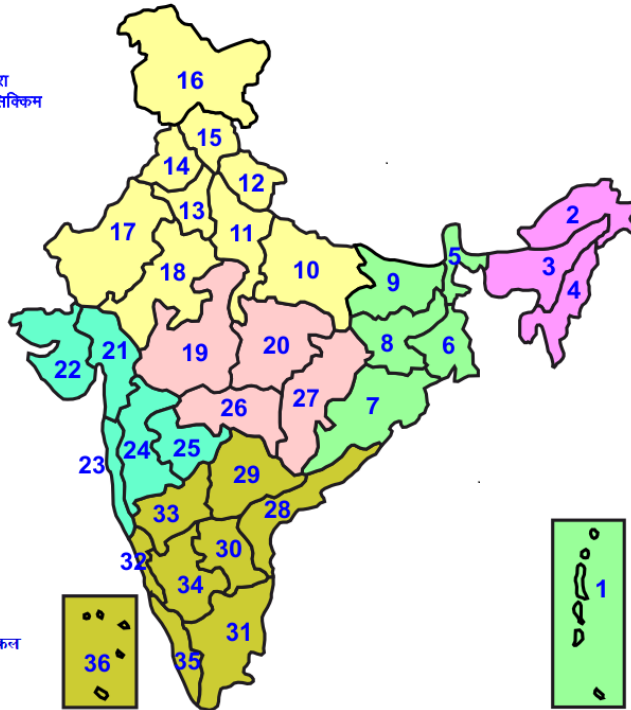
