# All India Impact Based Weather Warning Bulletin

#### Thursday 30 March 2023 Time of Issue: 1930 hours IST

### (NIGHT)

**30 March (Day 1):** A Hailstorm accompanied with thunderstorm, lightning & gusty wind (40-50 kmph) very likely at isolated places over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi; with lightning & gusty wind (30-40 kmph) at isolated places over Rajasthan and with lightning & hail over Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand.

Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & gusty wind (40-50 kmph) very likely at isolated places over Odisha, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura; with lightning & gusty wind (30-50 kmph) at isolated places over Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Gangetic West Bengal, Bihar, Jharkhand, Kerala & Mahe and Rayalaseema and with lightning over Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan & Muzaffarabad, Uttar Pradesh, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Arunachal Pradesh, South Interior Karnataka, Coastal Andhra Pradesh Yanam, Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal and Telangana.

**31 March (Day 2):** ◆ **Heavy rainfall** very likely at isolated places over Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan & Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha and Assam & Meghalaya.

Hailstorm accompanied with thunderstorm, lightning & squally wind (50-60 kmph) very likely at isolated places over Gangetic West Bengal; with lightning & gusty wind (40-50 kmph) at isolated places over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Odisha, Bihar and Jharkhand; with lightning & gusty wind (30-40 kmph) at isolated places over Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan and Assam & Meghalaya and with lightning & hail over Himachal Pradesh.

◆ Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & gusty wind (40-50 kmph) very likely at isolated places over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura; with lightning & gusty wind (30-40 kmph) at isolated places over East Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Chhattisgarh, Kerala & Mahe and Rayalaseema and with lightning over Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan & Muzaffarabad, West Rajasthan, Arunachal Pradesh, Tamilnadu, Puducherry & Karaikal, Coastal Andhra Pradesh Yanam and Telangana.

**01 April (Day 3): Heavy rainfall** likely at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.

• Hailstorm accompanied with thunderstorm & lightning likely at isolated places over Uttarakhand.

◆ Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & gusty wind (40-50 kmph) likely at isolated places over Odisha; accompanied with lightning & gusty wind (30-40 kmph) at isolated places over Bihar, Jharkhand, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Kerala & Mahe and West Bengal Sikkim and with lightning over Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan & Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Uttar Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Coastal Andhra Pradesh Yanam, Rayalaseema and Telangana.

**02** April (Day 4): • Heavy rainfall likely at isolated places over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.

Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & gusty wind (30-40 kmph) likely at isolated places over Kerala & Mahe and West Bengal Sikkim and with lightning over Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan & Muzaffarabad, Coastal Andhra Pradesh Yanam and Telangana.


**03** April (Day 5): 
Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning & gusty wind (30-40 kmph) likely at isolated places over Kerala & Mahe and West Rajasthan and with lightning over Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan & Muzaffarabad, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Coastal Andhra Pradesh Yanam and Telangana.

# Impact expected and action suggested due to isolated thunderstorm with lightning/gusty winds & Hailstorm over

- 30th March: Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Rajasthan
- **31**<sup>st</sup> **March:** Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Uttar Pradesh, East Rajasthan, Odisha, Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal & Sikkim
- **01**<sup>st</sup> **April:** Uttarakhand

### Impact expected:

- Strong wind/hail may damage plantation, horticulture and standing crops.
- Hail may injure people and cattle at open places.
- Partial damage to vulnerable structures due to strong winds.
- Minor damage to kutcha houses/walls and huts.
- Loose objects may fly.

### Action suggested:

- Stay indoors, close windows & doors and avoid travel if possible.
- Take safe shelters; do not take shelter under trees.
- Do not lie on concrete floors and do not lean against concrete walls.
- Unplug electrical/ electronic appliances.
- Immediately get out of water bodies.
- Keep away from all the objects that conduct electricity.


## **Advisory for farmers:**

- Postpone harvesting of matured crops in Arunachal Pradesh; keep already harvested produce in a safe place or cover the heaps of already harvested produce in the field with tarpaulin sheets.
- Complete the harvesting of matured crops in Jammu, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan during clear weather.
- Postpone sowing of maize in Arunachal Pradesh.
- Drain out excess water from crop fields and provide mechanical support to horticultural crops as well as staking to vegetables in Northeast India.
